Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What will be the format of the accelerated summer course?

The accelerated summer course will be for four weeks during the month of June. Class will be held in the morning at Roncalli Catholic. The course will be an online format that will be directed by and done collaboratively with the Benilde Director.

Q: How long will my student need to be in the Benilde Program?

Students are allowed to stay in the program all four years of their high school career if needed. Most students stay in the program for one to two years. The main goal of the Benilde Program is to help students learn the skills necessary to be successful in high school and then be able to utilize them independently in preparation for college.

Q: What will the daily Benilde class be like?

Students will cover various skills necessary to maximize their success at Roncalli Catholic. Areas such as self-advocacy, test-taking strategies, organizational skills, and study skills will be taught. The Benilde class will be able to adapt to individual student needs as necessary.

Q: What other schools have taught the Benilde Program?

The program started in Washington D.C. at St. John's College High School and has become a nationally recognized program. RCHS will be the first school in Nebraska to implement the Benilde Program.
