WHAT IS THE CAREER ACADEMY?

In partnership with Metropolitan Community College, the Career Academy is designed to provide high school juniors and seniors with opportunities to explore a variety of career fields such as nursing, civil engineering, theater technology, architecture, welding, information technology, auto mechanics, and many others. Students can use this opportunity to gain credits toward an associate's degree or certificate in these fields while still in high school.



WHAT WILL I LEARN?

- Practical skills and information for specific career areas
- Safety procedures
- Job-seeking skills
- Interpersonal skills for the workplace



WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

To enroll in the Career Academy, students must:

- Be a high school junior or senior
- Be at least 16 years old
- Be selected to participate by application
- Have transportation to and from classes and internship/apprenticeship site

With the help of a generous donation from an alumnus, Roncalli Catholic is happy to be able to offer students the opportunity to take these college level courses at a reduced cost, or no cost at all. This provides our students a real jumpstart on their future careers. Available funding will be divided by the number of students who are accepted to the program, up to full paid tuition. There are many ways to provide access to this program at little or no cost to our students.

WHAT CAREERS CAN I EXPLORE?

There are 22 Academies to choose from, with pathways to high-demand career fields. Our students have a nearly 100% employment rate following completion of the Career Academy program at Metropolitan Community College.
